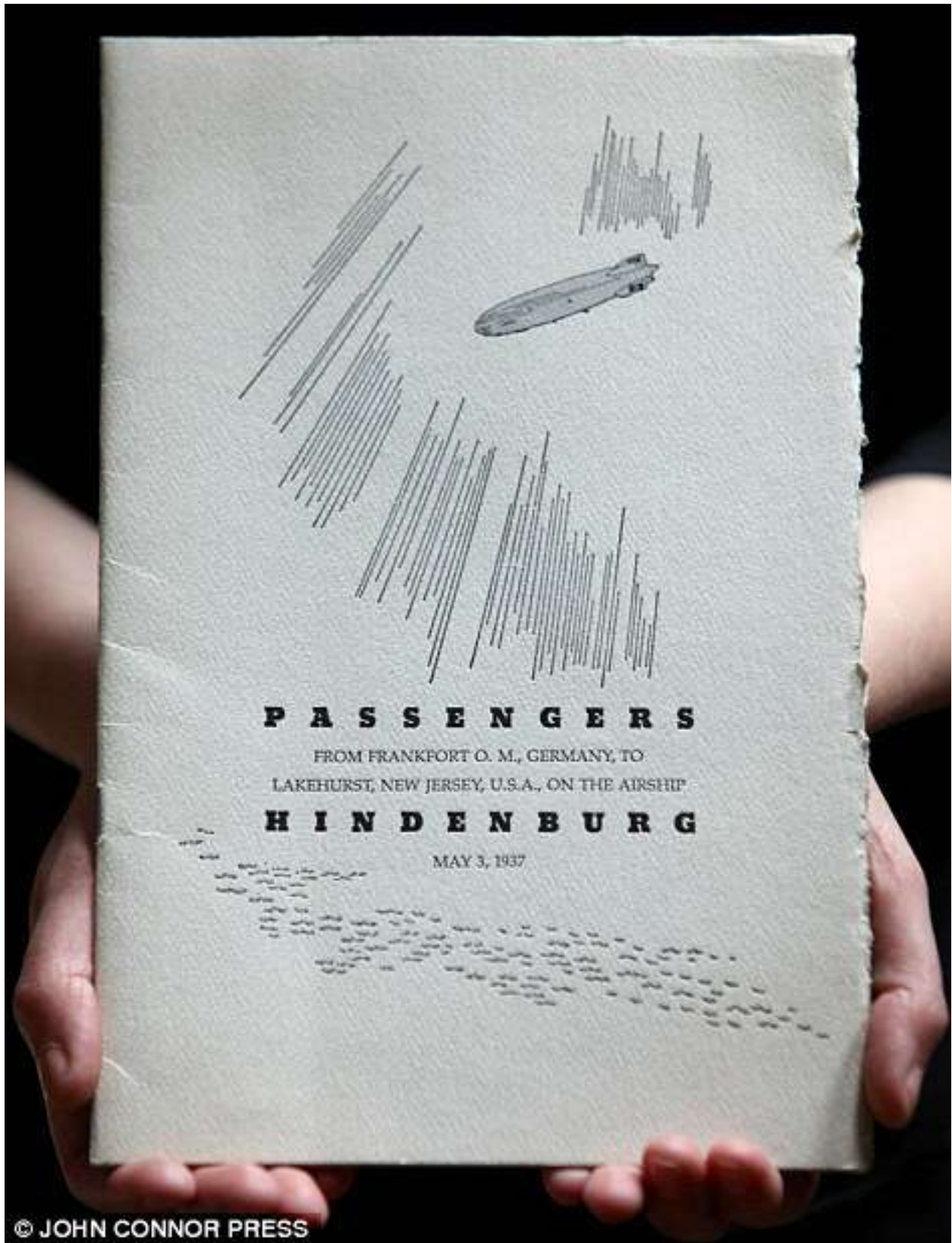

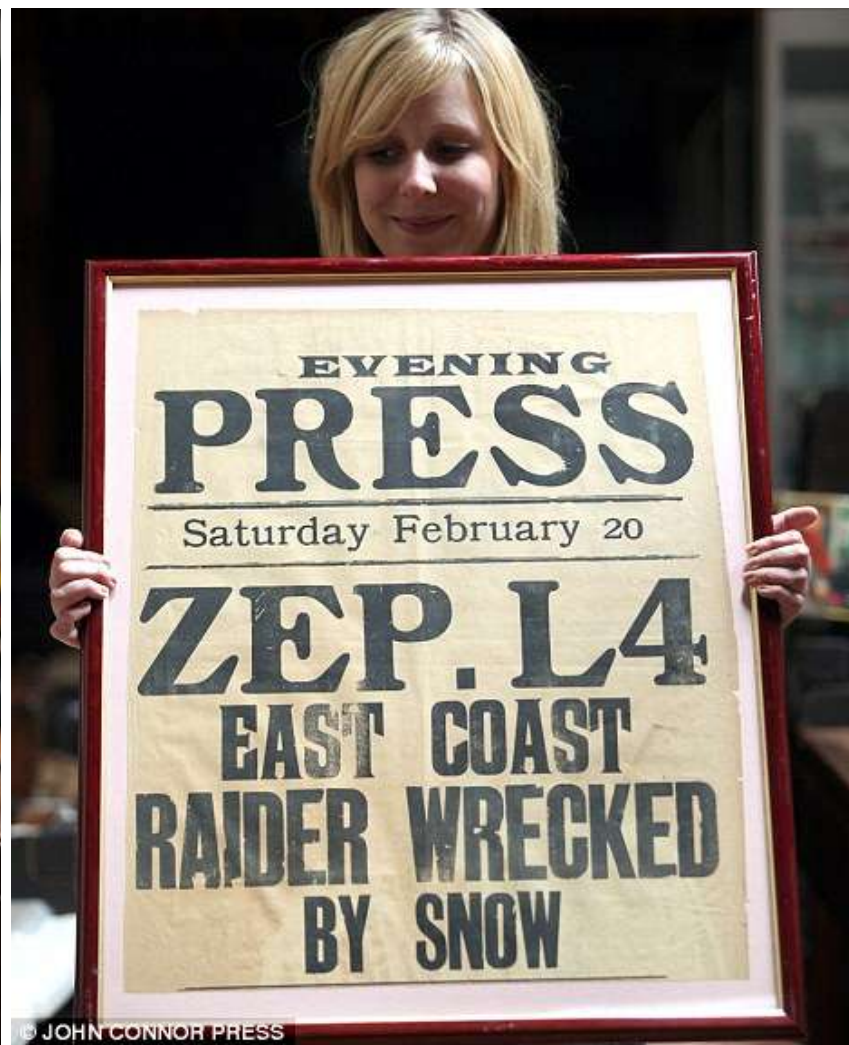

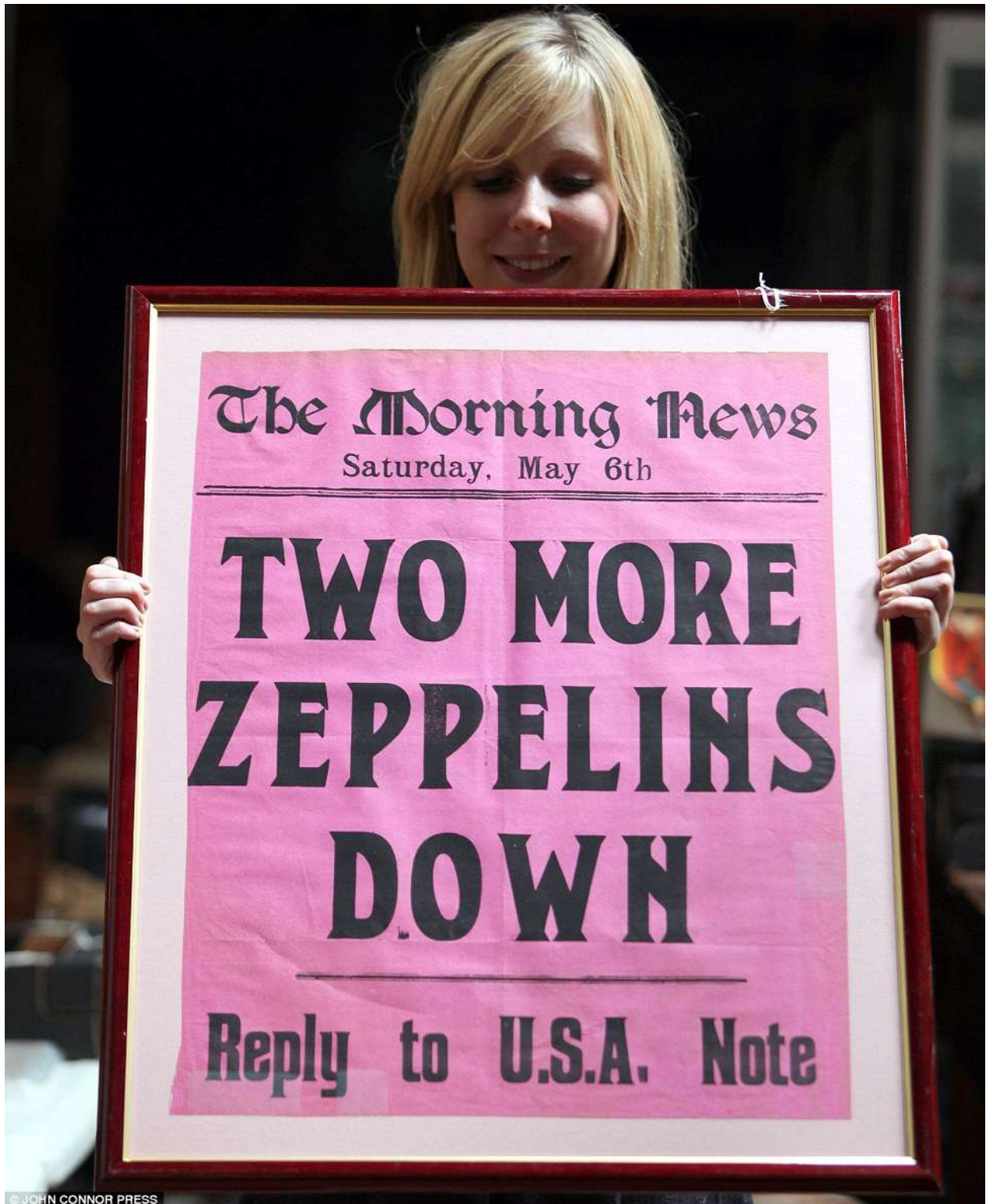
An airship cocktail shaker in the shape of a Zeppelin is one of 600 items that are up for sale -

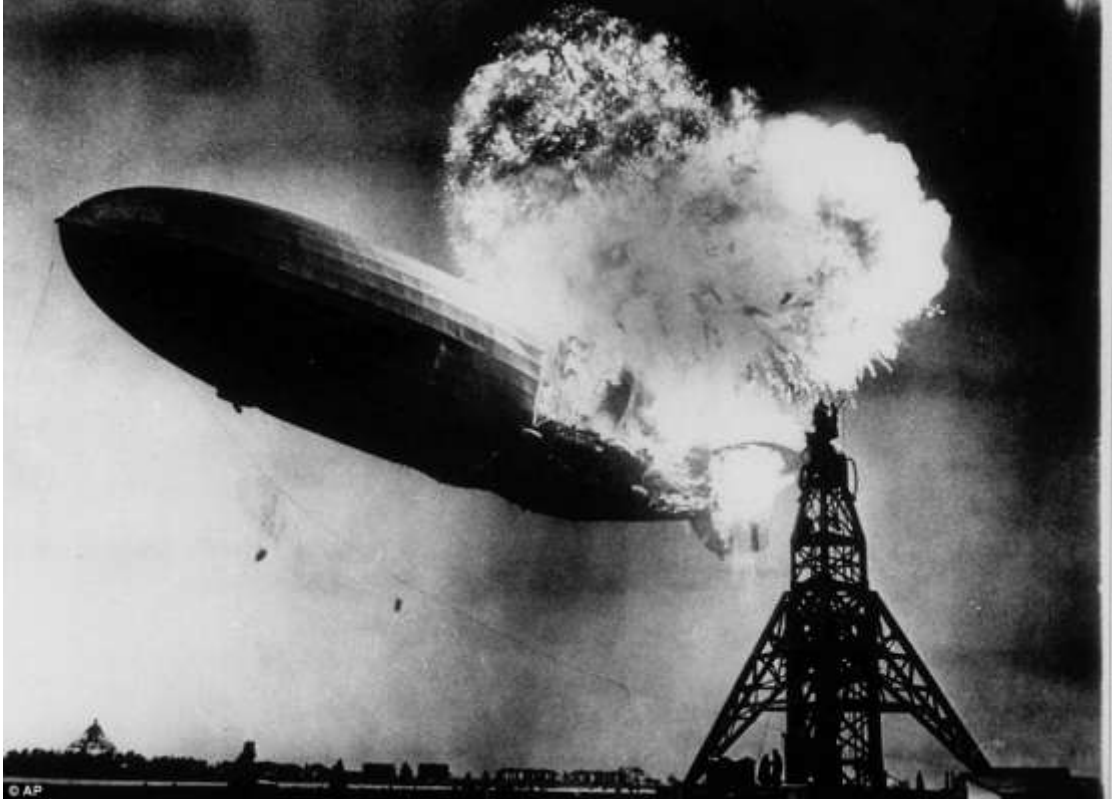
